01. Kindergarden& primary school

Kindergarten activities include brief moments of **play and interaction** with the artworks, where children are accompanied in the active exploration of the exhibitions. Activities are framed in two phases: observation and narration. Children are invited to dwell on the images, analyzing their details and shapes, while practicing their verbal skills in descriptions. They familiarize then with the images while learning **how to sharpen their gaze in identifying key elements of the artwork**.

Primary school activities, on the other hand, engage children in observing the artworks, raising questions and stimulating narration. **Art becomes a spring-board for imagining stories and developing critical, expository and speculative skills.** Children become familiar with the language of painting, the history of the artwork and the artist. They are also involved in an exercise of imagination, by making up a story about one of the paintings.



WHAT DO YOU SEE?

For Kindergarden

Creative exercises with shapes and colours: the works on display in the exhibition prompt observations and comparisons from which the children build a visual diary of the museum experience.

LET ME TELL YOU A STORY

For Primary School

Leading figures of the 20th century populate the rooms, with poses, clothing and scenarios that mirror their times. The class creates a story using their collective imagination, selecting images and moods and following the narrative structure of a fairy tale. This creative exercise develops language skills and visual literacy.

02. Junior and High School

The activities for junior school students offer the opportunity to experience the museum as a space for sharing and free expression. The aim is to address a critical and careful look to the works, to discuss current events, personal experiences and contemporary and artistic contexts.

AMONG US / ICÔNES

For Secondary School Students

For this programme, the class works in small groups to produce a collective project. The themes of the exhibition are first introduced, then the class are asked to relate, contributing their own personal experiences and interests. Connections and links will be discussed in order to create something new: a narrative text, a poem, a drawing, or a video, at the students' discretion and according to their interests.

This is a highly interactive visit that is very effective in engaging students.

EXTENDED VISIT / ICÔNES

For Secondary School Students

This is a complete tour of the exhibition, based on conversation and dialogue, with the full participation of students. The artistic languages and theoretical issues addressed by the works in the exhibition are discussed in depth, expanding the students' views on contemporary society.

AMONG US / CHRONORAMA

For Secondary School Students

The *Chronorama* exhibition presents photos that were published in Condé Nast magazines throughout the 20th century: it takes students on a journey across the century, through the lens of fashion and style.

The images exhibited accompanied written articles and stories, and the class, organised into small groups, is likewise inspired to produce texts and images that reflect their own point of view. The creative process is sparked by observation of the works and discussion and comparison within the groups.

EXTENDED VISIT / CHRONORAMA

For Secondary School Students

This is a complete tour of the exhibition, based on conversation and dialogue, with the full participation of students. The historical and aesthetic elements characterising the different decades of the 20th century will be addressed in depth. Classes are invited to interact, observe, and express their own opinions related to the works and their context, in dialogue with the museum guide.

EXPRESS VISIT / CHRONORAMA

For Secondary School Students

An introduction is given and the exhibition is contextualized, so that students may then explore the exhibition on their own. The explanation provides the necessary tools for students to discover the exhibition freely, with no fixed itinerary.

ACTIVITIES THAT CAN BE BOOKED IN BOTH EXHIBITIONS

CLIL CONTENT AND LANGUAGE INTEGRATED LEARNING

The students bring their knowledge and language skills into play in relation to contemporary art themes: a visit to the exhibitions is an opportunity to learn specific vocabulary and test their expressive skills in the context of the museum. The activity involves each group focusing on a different semantic field and, in relation to the works, producing texts of various kinds, whether narrative, poetic or descriptive.
