THE WORLD AS IT GOES

From 20 March to 2 September 2024

In the spring of 2024, a set of iconic works from the Pinault Collection will be displayed throughout the Bourse de Commerce, like a dizzying spiral within which images highlight François Pinault's passion for, and commitment to, contemporary art.

Bringing together works mainly from the 1980s to the present day, the exhibition reveals the heightened awareness of the present that artists express. *The World as It Goes*, the title of which is borrowed from Voltaire's philosophical tale, presents major artists including Maurizio Cattelan, Peter Doig, Marlene Dumas, Damien Hirst, Martin Kippenberger, Jeff Koons, Sigmar Polke and Cindy Sherman.

Faced with the excesses and paradoxes of our society and our world, as well as the difficulties of our time, the artists are at times prophetic and visionary, at others philosophical. Sometimes they are cynical and ironic, often they are poetic and re-enchanting. It is the flow of images taken in by the world's motions, the ability of the works to reflect reality or, to the contrary, to create a mise en abyme around it, to resonate in empathy or irony with the past and present that have nourished the Pinault Collection for the last fifty years.

In parallel to the works on show, Korean artist **Kimsooja** presents a carte blanche entitled *To Breathe — Constellation*, in the Rotunda, the display cases and the basement of the museum.

On the day of your visit

Before your visit, we ask you print or download your tickets, available in your professional account.

We ask the person in charge of the group to arrive 20 minutes before the beginning of the visit at the Bourse de Commerce. The person in charge of the group is responsible for the supervision of the visit and will bring the whole group into the museum when it is complete.

- If you have booked a guided tour, the educator will welcome you to begin your visit of the Bourse de Commerce – Pinault Collection.
- If you have booked a self-guided tour, you may buy, if needed, additional tickets for the members of your group at the Information-Ticket Desk, our reception and ticketing area located opposite the museum entrance, at 40 rue du Louvre.
- Audiophones required for guided or self-guided tours will be given to you at the Group welcome desk at level -2, once you have passed the museum access control.

CANCELLATION TERMS

Please note that any delay reduces the visit time. If you are more than 30 minutes late, the visit will be cancelled and payment will be due.

You may postpone or cancel your visit and get a refund for your purchase, provided you let our team know:

- For a guided tour, no later than 15 days before the visit date.
- For a self-guided or independent tour, no later than 5 days before the visit date.
 Please note that in this case the booking fee (€40) will not be refunded.
